


Using eConsults to Support Dermatological Needs in Primary Care

- Assess rashes, wounds, or other lesions and abnormalities
- Determine whether additional testing or follow-up is necessary based on the patient's history
- Provide follow-up recommendations for developing a treatment plan

Rashes

38 y/o female patient presents with a new pruritic rash that only appears at cold temperatures.


Question: Based on the history and photos, does cold urticaria appear to be the correct dx, and what are your treatment recommendations? Would you recommend any additional workup if ice cube test is inconclusive?



Dermatitis

75 y/o male patient with lower extremity rash, unresolved for 10 months.

Question: What management would you recommend for venous stasis dermatitis with new ulcer?



Wounds

36 y/o male patient presents with a laceration to right inner thigh, repaired with sutures, now with concern for wound infection.

Question: What is the appropriate antibiotic selection for this wound? When should the patient be referred to a wound clinic?
